Program Highlights

Rescue

Rescue partners helped place 309 animals in January

Foster

 KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of January 33 animals entered foster care

TNR

 In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through January 2016, 3,909 cats have been altered through the TNR Program

Adoptions

In January 356 animals went to forever homes

Spay/Neuter clinics

- In January we held two successful mobile spay/neuter clinics:
 - January 14th-15th in Taft
 - January 22nd in Frazier park
- Each day 30 surgeries were performed totaling 90 surgeries in January


