Program Highlights

Rescue

• Rescue partners helped place 405 animals in May.

Foster

• KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of May 296 animals entered foster care and there are currently 370 animals in foster care.

TNR

• In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through May, 2019, 8,671 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

KCAS had "Salty's BBQ Dinner with the Dogs" adoption event




In May KCAS was joined by Kern County Veterans Services and held their annual "Animals for Armed Forces Event"
