Program Highlights

Rescue

• Rescue partners helped place 2,850 animals in 2019.

Foster

• KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in 2019, 1,703 animals went through the foster care program. There are currently 93 animals in foster care.

TNR

• In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through December 2019, 9,625 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.
