Program Highlights

Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 153 animals in October

Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of October 122 animals entered foster care.

TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through October 2016, 4,973 cats have been altered through the TNR Program

Spay/Neuter clinics

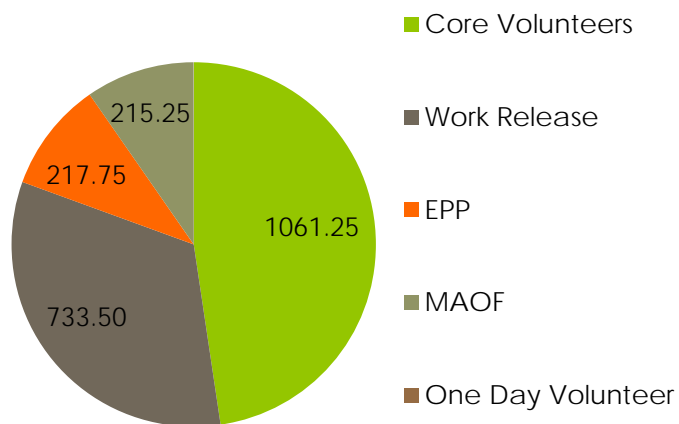

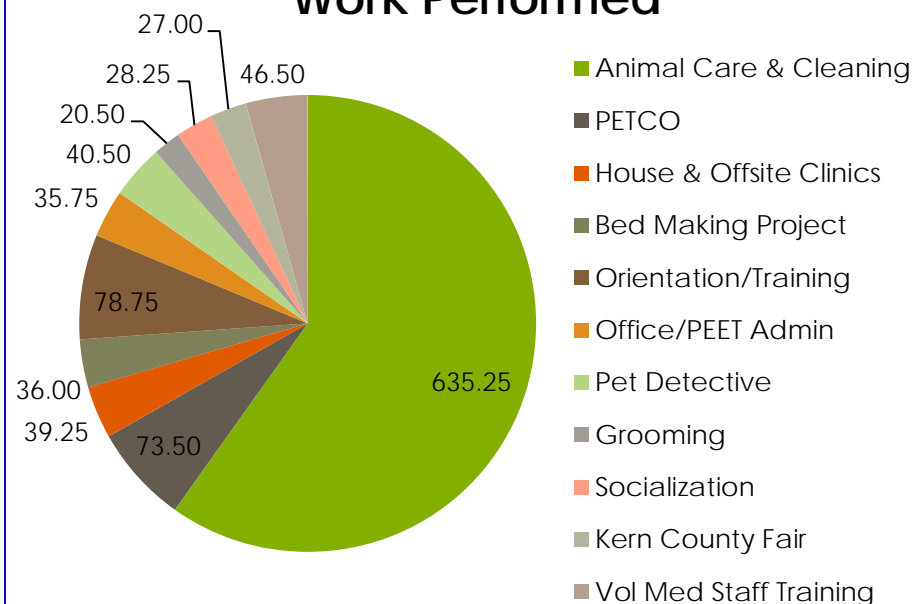
Volunteers
