# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 2,285 animals in 2016

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow and in 2016 1,210 animals entered foster care.

## TNR

- In 2016, 1,398 cats have been altered through the TNR Program

## Offsite vaccination clinics

- 2016 Year-to-date
  - 1,860 Rabies
  - 1,203 DHPP
  - 2,054 Licenses
  - 498 microchips
  - 58 FVRCP

## Wednesday evening vaccination clinics

- 2016 Year-to-date
  - 2,779 Rabies
  - 2,530 DHPP
  - 2,638 Licenses
  - 821 microchips
  - 289 FVRCP



## Adoptions

- KCAS successfully placed 5,381 animals in new homes in 2016
- 276 cats have been adopted from the Petco partnership in 2016

## Volunteers

- Volunteers donated approximately 28,637 total hours in 2016 which is equivalent to approximately 13.8 staff members
- The value that has been given back to KCAS by volunteers is approximately \$625,324
