- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through March, 2018, 7,145 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

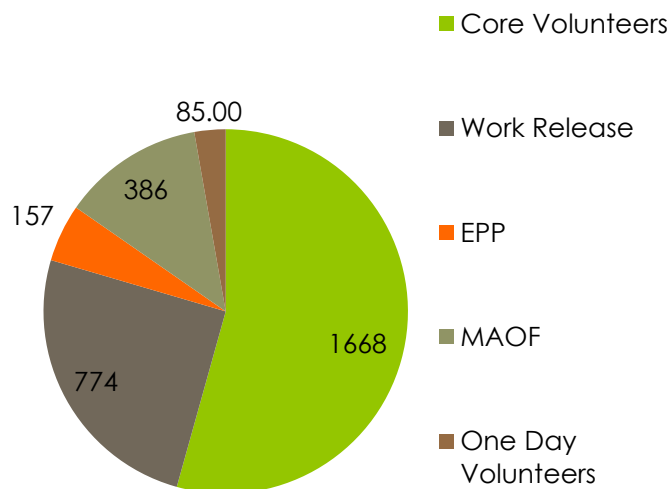

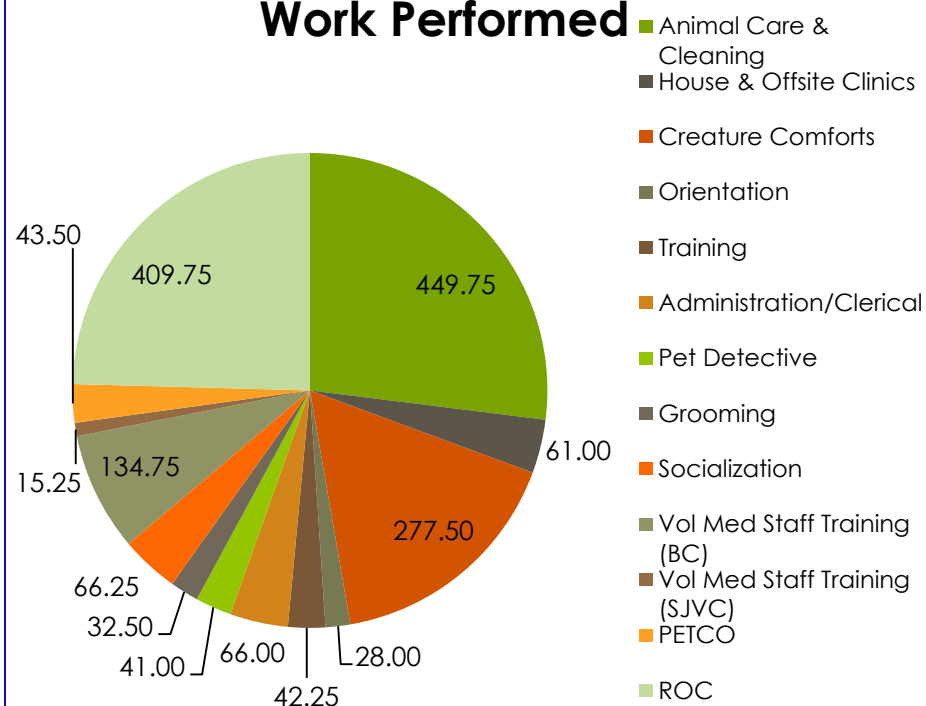
Volunteers
