Who is eligible: Low-income residents in unincorporated Bakersfield zip codes 93305, 93306 and 93307 and unincorporated areas of Lamont, Eastern Kern, Taft, Shafter and Arvin. Current ID or utility bill required to verify address. maximum 3/household

Surgery fee: \$30

(Additional charges may be incurred at the doctor's discretion, and the applicant will be responsible for those charges. These charges are based on the age and condition of the dog at time of the procedure and other unforeseen circumstances, and will vary from case to case. The applicant has the right to deny service before any charges are incurred, and will receive full refund of the \$30 fee, provided no services have been rendered whatsoever.
