- Rescue partners helped place 288 animals in June

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of June 190 animals entered foster care

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through June 2017, 5,931 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.
