# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 188 animals in March.

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of March 107 animals entered foster care and there are currently 170 animals in foster care.

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through March, 2019, 8,489 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

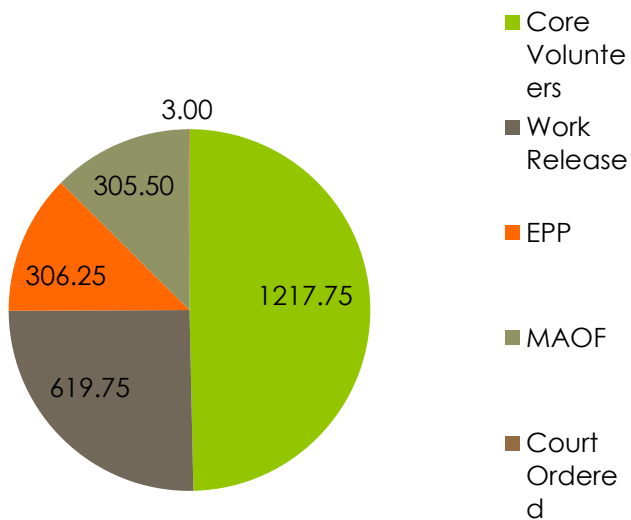

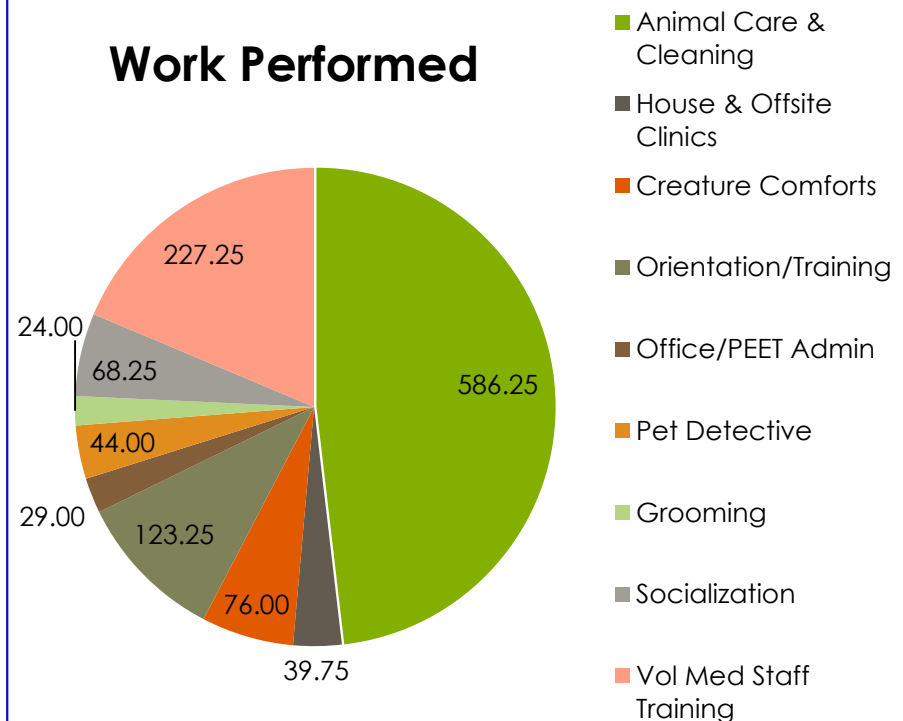
# Volunteers
