# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 405 animals in May.

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of May 296 animals entered foster care and there are currently 370 animals in foster care.

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through May, 2019, 8,671 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

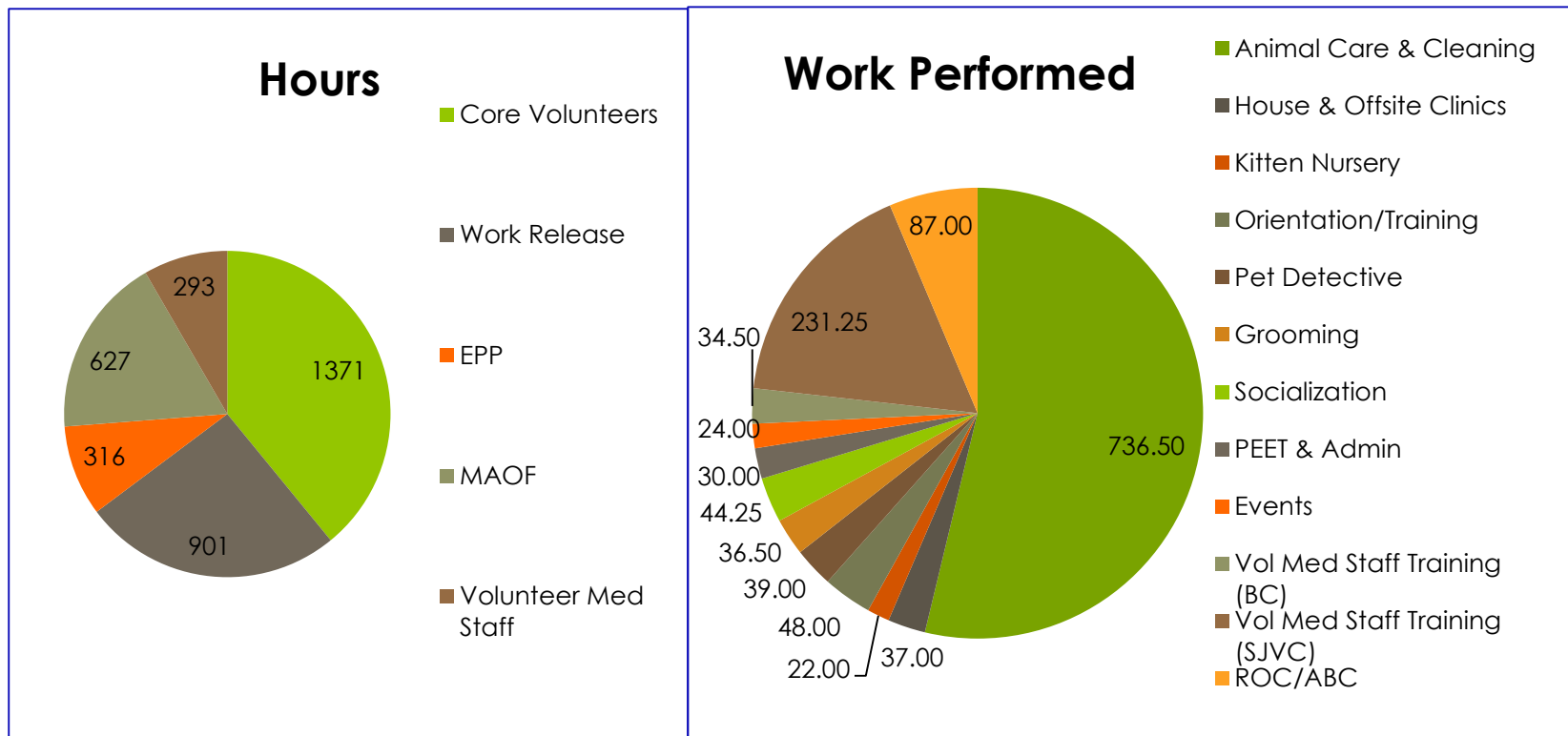
