# Program Highlights

## Rescue

- Rescue partners helped place 192 animals in July.

## Foster

- KCAS Foster program continues to grow, and in the month of July 172 animals entered foster care and there are currently 266 animals in foster care.

## TNR

- In 2013 KCAS implemented a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Through July, 2019, 8,818 cats have been altered through the TNR Program.

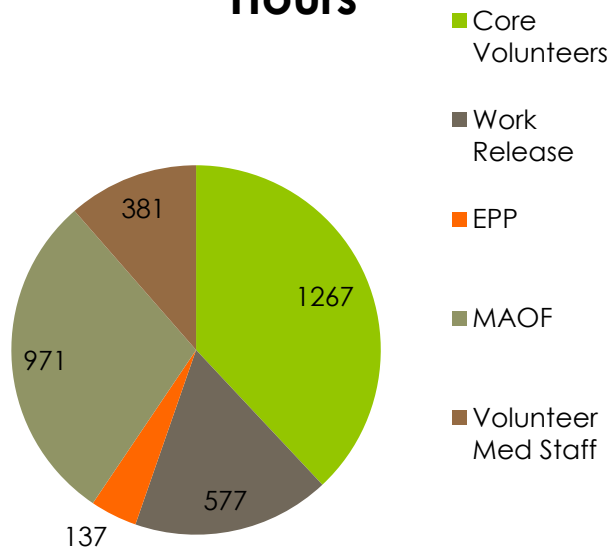

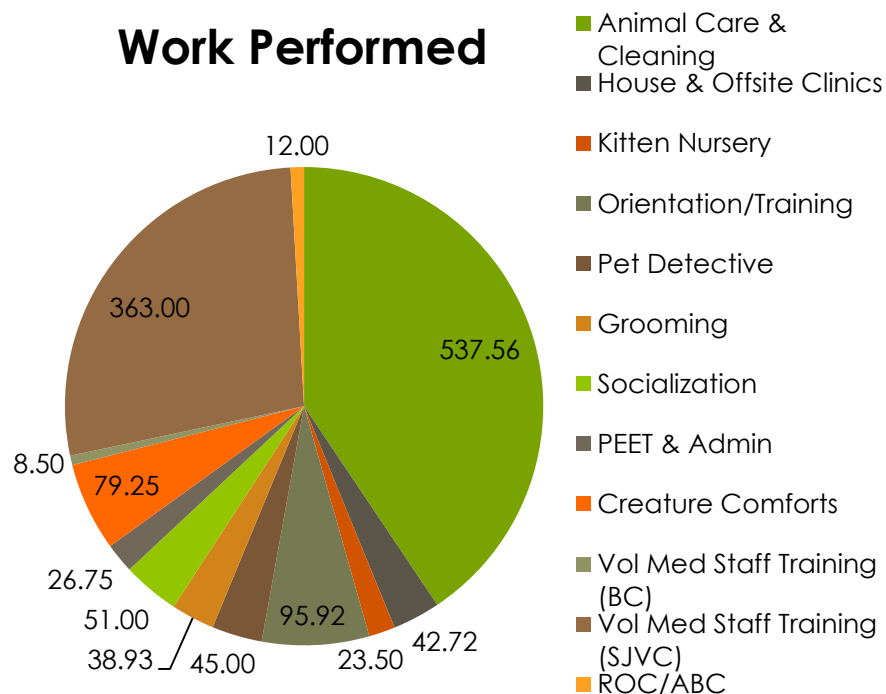
# Volunteers
