

Cheat Sheet: Homepage Header Image/News Items

To Ensure the Homepage Looks Good at Desktop and Mobile

Tip 1: Images – Use the correct size

The dimensions to use for these images is:

Height: minimum 500 pixels

Width: minimum 2000 pixels

Tip 2: Images - Do not use images with text.

This page is designed to have any text appear in the blue box, overlaying the image. If the image has text it could conflict with the overlay text (Banner Title and Banner Caption).

Tip 3: Images - Make sure the main subject of the image is centered, horizontally and vertically

The main image can be resized based on the size of the screen, dramatically for different mobile devices. The horizontal and vertical center will always be centered, no matter what device is used.

Tip 4: Text Overlay – Make sure the text is not too long

Text that is too long on the Banner Title (large text) or the Banner Caption (small text below the banner title) could cause issues on mobile devices. It could get cut off or some lines could disappear entirely. If this occurs when testing on mobile devices (Tip 5) you should shorten one or both until everything appears on phones and tablets.

Tip 5: Testing – Test on desktop and the most popular phones and tablets
